Central CBAC update: presented report early May due to code changes in Feb. Report identified problems: time crunch; sense of lack of diversity on CBACs but no data; recruitment, retention & compliance - ex, 6 have fewer than members, 10% folks serving



	unlawfully can't get confirmation from County attorney or OCI; still required to use public mtg law despite County opinion. If can't answer basic legal questions, it opens up possible rule of law violations. CBAC improvement process led by OCI (not informed by Central CBAC). July 8 BOCC hearing. -How many members? 9 -Sense lower # CBACs is recruitment problem or attrition? Seen no data re: application #s
Survey and Stipends	Based on code changes, CBAC members can receive - Voluntary - OCI has resources for meetings attended this year (not sure what initial date is) - \$35 - Next fiscal year becomes dept responsibility - Have to fill out vendor form, W9, and ACH – need wet signatures - If >\$600, get 1099 Q&A • Does stipend include childcare? • Policy for this fiscal year is all inclusive at \$35 • HSD rate is higher • Can people who attended meetings unofficially still get stipends? Bill will ask • Should emphasize in recruitment
