


Cross Sector Case Conference (CSCC) Release of Information Quick Guide

November 2024



Collecting the Release of Information (ROI) - Prior to Case Conferencing

Prior to case conferencing, CSCC Facilitator will need to confirm that an ROI has been signed and uploaded into the Homelessness Information Management System (HMIS).

Participants prioritized for the upcoming session without a signed CSCC ROI cannot be case

conferenced, as protected identifiable (PII) and health information (PHI) cannot be shared without written consent. Additionally, a separate release for 42 CFR Part 2 will be necessary for the discussion of any services relating to substance use disorder diagnosis, prognosis, or treatment.

Transacting ROIs in HMIS

Signed ROIs are transacted and uploaded into HMIS in the same way that the Multnomah County Data Sharing Agreement (Multco ROI) and Coordinated Access ROI are entered. - Through the ROI tab as seen above.


- ★ Click on the "ROI" tab
- ★ Then "Add Release of Information"
- ★ Only include the Head of Household in the ROI


