How do things work with the Oregon Health Plan (OHP)?

The Oregon Health Plan (OHP)* covers doctor visits, prescriptions, hospital stays, dental care, mental health services, and help with addiction to cigarettes, alcohol, and drugs. OHP can provide glasses, hearing aids, medical equipment, home healthcare, transportation to healthcare appointments, and health-related services.

Health Share of Oregon – Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder Treatment Plan

CareOregon manages the Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder services benefits for OHP/Health Share members for all above <u>IDS plans</u>. Individuals may engage in services for Mental Health or Substance Use Disorder treatment without a referral from the Primary Care Provider. In some cases they may need to get Prior Authorization through CareOregon.

Why is it important to go to my assigned Primary Care Provider?

Under OHP, to see specialists, get home health services, durable medical equipment, and some prescriptions, patients need to establish care with their assigned Primary Care Provider (PCP). PCP contact information is on insurance cards, or patients can call their CCO or IDS to find out who their PCP is. Establishing care with a PCP may give access to additional help like social work, care management, behavioral health support, and health-related services.

What if I want to change my Provider or health plan?

- To change from Health Share to Trillium or vice versa, call OHP customer service 1-800-273-0557.
- To change insurance plans (IDS) under Health Share of Oregon, call Health Share of Oregon at 503-416-1460.
- To switch to another health or mental health/SUD treatment provider with Trillium plan, call Trillium at 877-600-5472.
- To change to a different provider within your assigned IDS plan with Health Share of Oregon, call that specific plan to request a change of PCP. See table on page 1.
- To change to a different mental health/SUD treatment provider under Health Share/Care Oregon, call CareOregon 503-416-4100 or use Find a Provider to locate in-network services.
