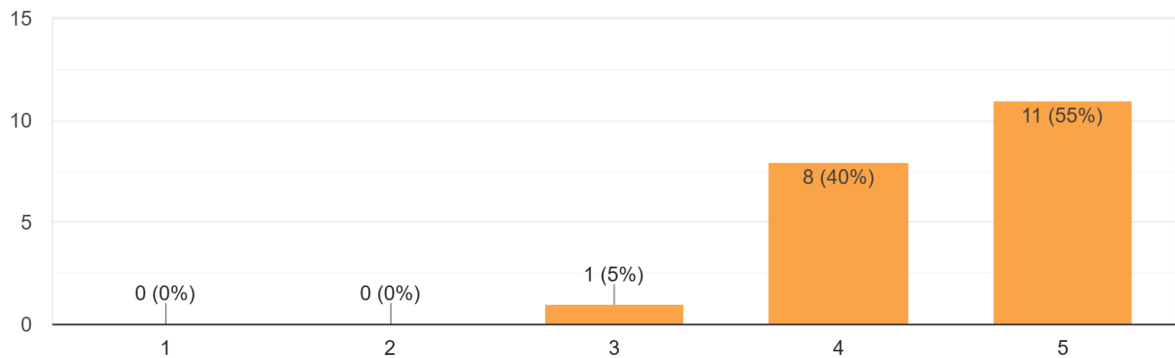

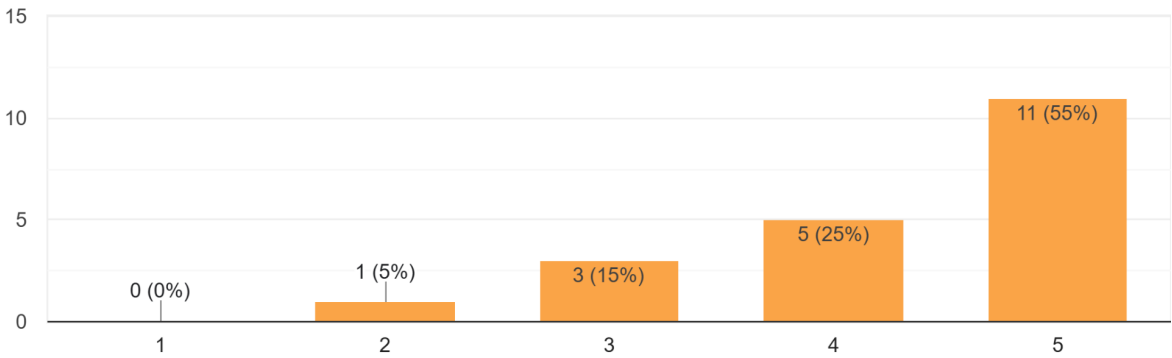

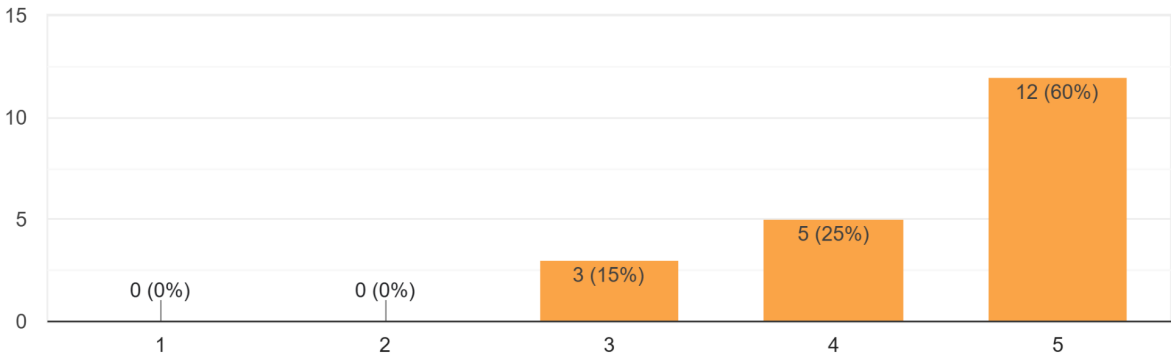

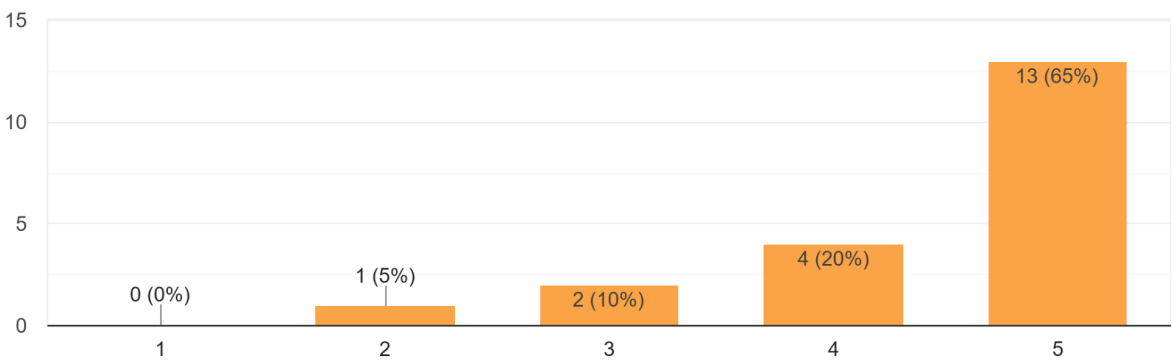

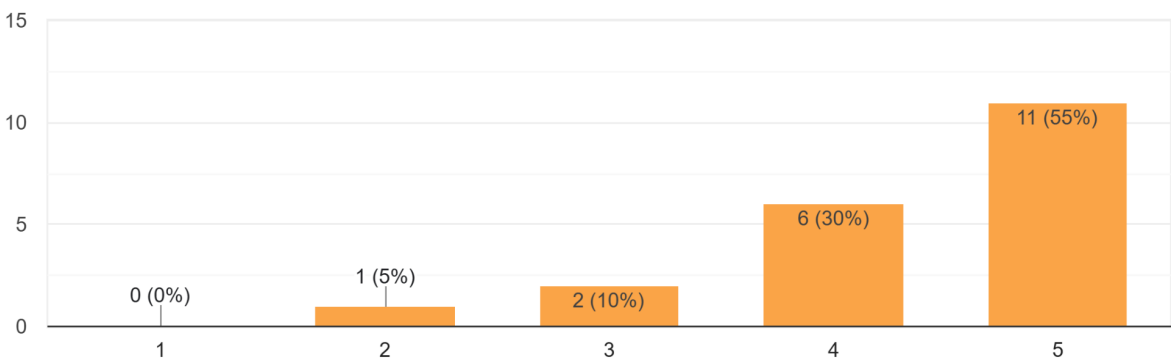

- "For future conferences, my recommendation is to enhance the physical conference materials we receive at check-in. While the folder and notepad provided this year were an awesome touch, I believe having a physical session guide is a missing piece that would elevate the experience.
- Specifically, I would love to see a printed reference sheet included in the folders that provides a brief description of what is being discussed in each session and workshop.
- While I understand the shift toward digital formats and QR codes, relying solely on a smartphone can be distracting and less effective. Having to constantly pull out a phone to check a map or verify a speaker often leads to clicking away or losing track of the information entirely. A physical piece of paper goes a long way. Having a tangible guide allows attendees to see all the options at once, absorb the schedule, and thoughtfully navigate their day without the digital friction. I highly recommend bringing back a physical layout for the session descriptions next year!
