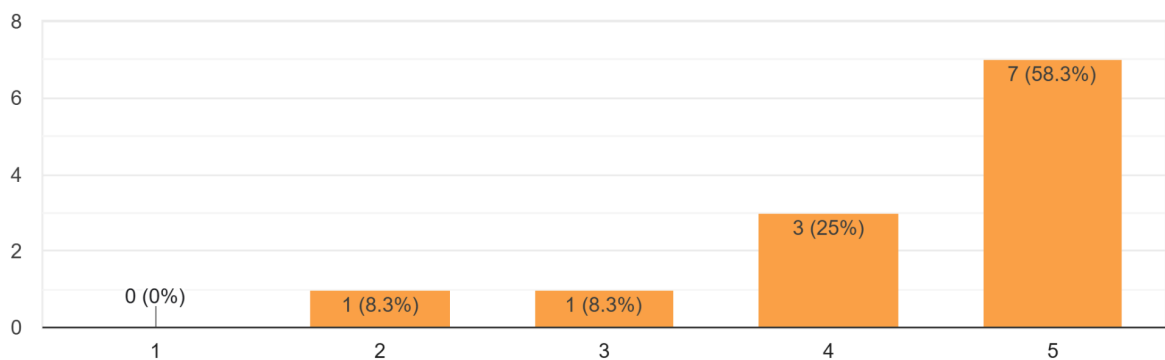

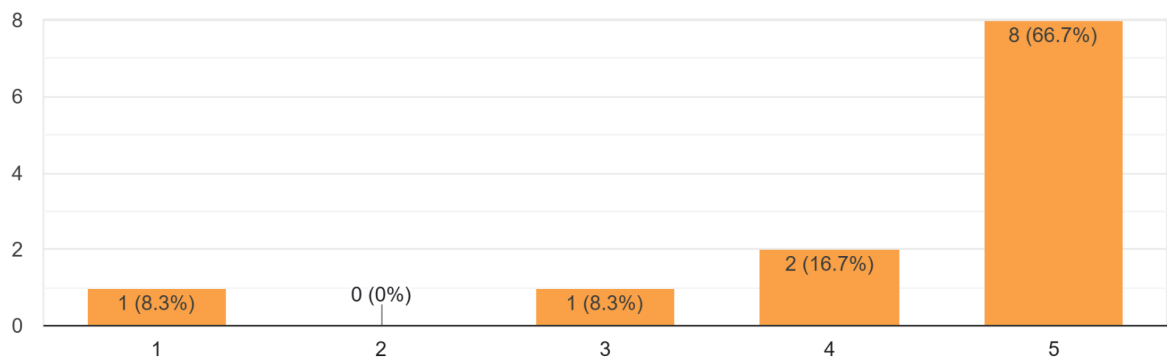

- Most of the information here is metrics based. Conceding that level of abstraction, this information wasn't well analyzed. I think it would be more helpful to bring in a PSU professor or independent statistician to discuss what the raw data portends. The HSD staff on the HRAP have a vested interest in presenting the data to tell a specific narrative (that the HRAP is a good IGA and is working well). It is not appropriate give them a direct presenting role. Next time, look for a neutral expert to digest and present on HRAP's data, analysis, and conclusions.
